

# Tick management survey

You are invited to have your say on the future of cattle tick management in Queensland.

A new framework for managing cattle tick implemented under the Biosecurity Act 2014 will start on June 30.

The main mechanism for managing cattle tick will be through the regulatory provisions contained in the Biosecurity Regulation.

The regulation will establish two biosecurity zones for cattle tick, the free zone and the infested zone, separated by the tick line.

The location of the tick line is yet to be decided. You can view our online map showing three options for the location of the of the new tick line.
