Designing sustainable farm landscapes in the North East Darling Downs region

Early in 2011, the North East Downs Landcare region experienced heavy rainfall and flooding events. The extreme weather conditions caused numerous problems for landholders on sloping farming country. These events changed the traditional course of flood water. The changes have resulted in erosion occurring on land that had not previously experienced erosion. The aim of the project is to protect and sustainably manage farming land. Farmers will be engaged to map their properties using baseline mapping, Spot 5 imagery and on ground technical observation to identify problem areas. When mapping is completed landholders can begin on-ground works to prevent the problems occurring again.
