

RABBIT FIELD DAY

With the assistance of Craig Rosenthal, Toowoomba Regional Council, We held a very informative workshop at Selwyn & Cheryl Peter's property on the 5th September on how to eliminate rabbits. This was an extremely bleak and cold day out with some drizzle as well, and not for the faint hearted. Craig demonstrated the method of treating rabbit warrens with Pestox and we are hoping the ones the crew treated will have numerous dead rabbits in them by now. This really is the easiest method. Craig does have some Pindone available to any landholders who wish to use it. This is a more time consuming practice as you need to put out a trail of oats for a few days to gauge the number of rabbits taking the seed before you apply poison to it. More than one application of Pindone may be needed, as rain followed by fresh green grass may prevent the Pindone working. The crew will be available to use Pestox in burrows for you free of charge by early October. All we ask is you draw a map of your paddock and mark off where you think the burrows are to make it easier for the crew, or meet the crew on site and advise them of the locations.

Please phone me to book in the crew if you are interested in this.

You will need to supply some empty grain bags 20k size or smaller for soil to be placed in to block off the burrows.
